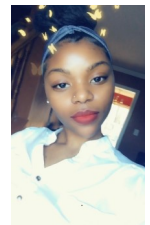
Gianni Pearson

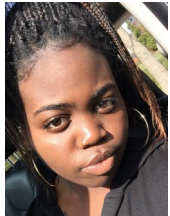


Eddie Ransom Jr

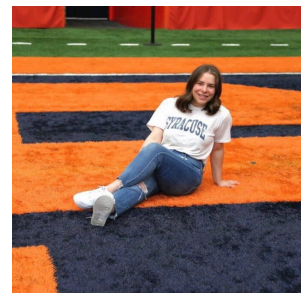


Lando Dinga

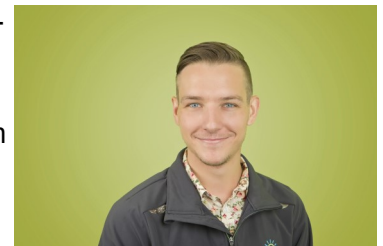
Liza Dupler
