
## LUDLOW-TAYLOR PTO UPDATE


In addition to our February calendar, which should have come home in backpacks yesterday and can be found on the last page of this Update, there are a lot of new announcements & reminders this week:

- PRIDE Committee Updates: At Tuesday's Happy Hour, we heard an update from 1st grade teacher, Ms. Atchsion, about some new PRIDE Committee behavior-related initiatives. First, L-T will be rolling out 2 <u>Buddy Benches</u> in the playground. The initiative was introduced to students during yesterday's morning announcements. Buddy benches are designed to help students build friendship, combat loneliness, and prevent bullying. Children can sit on the bench to signal that they are feeling lonely or isolated and need someone to reach out to them. Teachers will also read <u>The Buddy Bench</u> book to their classes (and 5 copies of it will be available in L-T's library) to help introduce students to the concept. Second, L-T will be bringing back the Students of the Week program to honor students -- one each week per grade level -- who exemplify PRIDE. Finally, new PRIDE signage will be going up throughout the school to remind students about behavioral expectations.
