- Addition Project Update: From Charles Allen: "I talked with the Chancellor a few times after getting feedback from the PTO meeting and their presentation on the addition. I raised serious concerns about the lack of engagement overall, and then specifically on the proposal to lose the existing garden space, proposed reuse of the area around our large tree, and proposal to move garden spaces onto the baseball field and it's impact on field needs for school and community. Overall to me, it feels like a lack of creatively solving for the needs. And in addition, DCPS seems to underplay that they're planning to keep this addition as a part of whatever full modernization comes later so decisions now will last a long time. After our calls this week, the Chancellor met with his team and gave me a call [over the weekend] to share that they have heard the concerns loud and clear and it doesn't look like DGS had consulted with DPR with their outlined plans. He said they are going to take a step back and pull these various partners together to revise plans, and then come back with some new and updated ideas to share. I don't have an exact timeline, but they're going to try and do this quickly."
